Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II founded the city in 1727, when he decided to shift his capital from Amer. A renowned architect,

astronomer, and avid scientist, Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II built his capital with geometric precision and made Jaipur one of the most well-planned cities in India.

Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel.

Evening enjoy the Cooking Demonstration followed by dinner in Dera Mandawa.

DAY 18 Thursday 27 November JAIPUR

Today you will visit the ancient capital of Amber to see the fabulous Amber Fort, followed by Historic Stepwell. Take a photo stop near Jal Mahal. Jal Mahal, also known as 'Water Palace' is a palace in the middle of the Man Sagar Lake in Jaipur city, the capital of the state of Rajasthan, India. The palace and the lake around it were renovated and enlarged in the 18th century by Maharaja Jai Singh II of Amber.

Continue sightseeing tour of Jaipur visiting City Palace, Observatory and Hawa Mahal. Then afterwards, walk through the old bazaar (market) of Jaipur, popularly known as Bapu Bazar. Overnight at Hilton Hotel Jaipur (B)



DAY 19 Friday 28 November

AGRA

After breakfast, you will travel to Agra. Famed with one of the Seven Wonders of the World - Taj Mahal, historical monuments, architectural grandeur ventures and the beauty of marbles, Agra thrives as one of the tourist destinations in India. The city is known for its superb inlay work on marble by craftsmen supposedly with a lineage dating back to the Mughals. Agra's handicrafts also include carpets, gold thread embroidery and leather shoes. Upon arrival in Agra, transfer to hotel and rest of the day will be at leisure.
